



Important Notice Regarding our Triple-Chrome Plated Accessories

If you have purchased any of our accessories in the triple-chrome plated finish that are going to be used on the exterior of your vehicle, you need to be aware of some important details.

Our chrome plating process is of the highest quality, and is the same process used by plating shops around the country for show-quality work. That said, these items are intended for use on vehicles that receive an above-average amount of care and maintenance, and following some simple guidelines will insure the longest life on your new part.

- 1) Chrome is very susceptible to pitting and flaking if exposed to road salts, acid rain, and other environmental agents that attack the metal. If the vehicle needs to be driven in the winter during snow season, or if it is parked near salt water all the time, chromed parts should be removed whenever possible, or washed with clean, fresh water after any exposure to minimize damage to the surface.
- 2) Never try to polish chrome parts with abrasives or pastes, as they normally will scratch the chrome surface and leave small swirl marks. Instead, gently clean the chrome with a cotton cloth and soapy water, or instead isopropyl alcohol may be used. Pieces may be waxed with quality waxes containing no abrasives to increase their life expectancy outdoors.
- 3) Whenever possible, keep the vehicle in a garage that will minimize the possibility of exposure to the elements such as acid rain or sprinkler systems which may spot or stain the chrome.

We offer a one-year warranty on all of our chrome plated products against manufacturing defects (chrome peeling, discoloration occurring during manufacture, etc.) but we do not warranty against defects caused by external sources, such as pitting from salts or water spotting caused by hard water or acid rain.
